Nursery/Reception/KS1 at 5:30 to 6:30 pm & KS2 at 6:45 to 7:45pm.


If you wish to leave your child at the KS2 disco, then the permission slip is attached to the end of this bulletin. Please complete beforehand and bring along with you on the night.
