I have been gobsmacked by your generosity! Today we held our fundraising day for the DEC Ukraine Humanitarian appeal and I as sit here writing this newsletter, my office team are counting up the cash from our cake sale. Before the cake sale this afternoon, we had already raised £263 from our blue and yellow non-uniform day for the appeal. We'll add the cake sale proceeds to the total and let you know the final total after the Easter holidays.

Here's where some of your money is going:-

£30 could provide essential hygiene supplies for three people for one month

£50 could provide blankets for four families

£100 could provide emergency food for two families for one month

It is very likely that thanks to your donations today, you have saved a life.

The DEC appeal has been running for one month, so far it has raised over £260,000,000 to help those fleeing war in Ukraine. To have been able to contribute a small amount to that and to have made a difference to Ukrainian children and their families is so humbling.


