Nesting Wagtails

Our reception children have been spell bound all day today! This morning, following a discussion about a nesting robin in one of the children's back gardens, they discovered a nesting family of grey wagtail birds in the reception courtyard. The nest is located in the overgrown wooden planter with the nest lodged in the long grass right next to the window in the reception corridor (a perfect spot for observing them). There are two adult birds who are feeding a nest of around 6 newly hatched chicks (the babies can't be more than a few days old). The children in reception and nursery have been making some really careful observations of the birds today and have discovered that the young need feeding a lot! Mummy and daddy wagtail make



lots of trips from the nest to find food and come back to feed the chicks. We don't want to disturb the birds and so with this in mind, we have put up some barriers around the box and ask politely that when parents and carers arrive to collect their children from the reception and nursery area, they take care to avoid the area where the birds are nesting and remain as quite as possible.
